NOTES TO ACCOUNTS:

- 1. The accounts of the RWA has been prepare for the period of 12 months starting from 1st April 2015 to 31st March 2016. And covering all the transactions made during the said period.
- 2. In case of admission fee received from the members to join the RWA have been capitalized and any life membership fee received from any members have also been capitalized and shown in the Balance sheet. And Incase of annual membership fees or any late fees received from members have been treated as revenue receipts and shown in Income & Expenditure accounts. In the year 2012-13 annual membership fee received from member had been capitalized but after decided by executive body of AVRWA the same fees have been recognized current year fees and shown in current financials.
- 3. The accounts of RWA have been prepared on Cash basis.
- 4. During the period under review, the RWA has filed the case against the builder Company of the "Amrapali Village" in the National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission (NCDRC), New Delhi vide case no CC/271/2011. The status of the case yet to be ascertains.. For the purpose of the case the contribution received towards legal cost are being treated as capital receipt and are being transferred to a separate fund "LCC Fund". Amount available in this fund exclusively utilized in connection with the expenses incurred for the case.
- 5. The RWA is maintaining their bank account with Indian Bank, Gaur Gravity Mall, Indirapuram and RWA bank account no. is 851893639.
- 6. During the year as per books of accounts the Society, I came to know that the society have made cash payment more than 20000/- to various vendors. As information provided by the members that they don't have knowledge about cash payment rules therefore they have made payments.
- 7. During the year, the members have informed that they are in process to take maintenance from the builder. Hence during the year the books of account not reflect any maintenance income as this amount directly receive by builders. During the year the RWA collections are comprises only festival collections which are received from the residents voluntarily.
