


ELECTION CODE OF CONDUCT

This code of conduct (COC) is applicable to all enrolled RWA members of Amrapali Village, including voters and contestants

- Existing RWA will remain functional till the formation and election of office new office bearers who will take charge from the incumbent RWA office bearers
- No Individual either part of the current Governing Body or new contesting candidates will use common Email/Messaging Group (including whatsapp group) as a platform, in any capacity, to highlight individual's efforts or achievements or personal agenda.
- Existing RWA/members must, in all cases, will use the official RWA mail Id for sharing any update or information with the general residents in the society.
- No Candidate can use defamatory remarks against individuals or the current body of representatives at any platform.
- No Candidate will invite or involve any third party or outsider to promote his/her election campaign.
- No candidate can indulge in his/her individual capacity in any financial transaction, whatsoever, in cash or in kind, neither in any common society functions and activities nor in convincing or commuting the voters to vote.
- No candidate/resident should spoil the society premises by putting posters or hoarding or banners
- Election campaign must end 24 hours prior to the starting time on the date of election.
- If anybody found violating any of the above mentioned rules in code of conduct, his/her nomination/voting rights will be cancelled with immediate effect.
- First owner who has cleared all the dues of RWA as well as maintenance as on 30th April will be eligible for contesting and voting in the election
- Only the first owner who is enrolled as RWA member is eligible to contest the election.
- Second owner or authorized representative of first owner can cast vote on production of authority letter dully signed by the first owner on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs 10/- in addition to the flat sales deed and photo ID proof, provided the first owner is a member of RWA
- In the unfortunate event of demise of the first owner, the co-owner is considered to be eligible to cast the vote on production of death certificate of the first owner
